

A STUDY OF GEOGRAPHY FROM TOPOONYMS OF THE VILLAGE'S NAME IN SUPHANBURI PROVINCE

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Abstract

The purpose of this research was to group the geographical names, and to analyze the geographical toponyms of the villages in Suphanburi province. By this research. A documentary research study was conducted with a sample of 1,008 villages in Suphanburi province. Geographical toponyms Indication Grouping Land use was found to have a total of 700 geographic names and 321 villages in the water and water areas, followed by highlands of 127 villages. The land use 97 villages, waterside area 69 villages, lowland area 54 villages, hill area 25 villages and island 7 villages.

Introduction

There are many names of geography, such as Kut Khok Khaom, Sub-Pum Som, Bang Nong Huay Mab, etc. Some names help to know the location of the political science of the place, such as Kut is a dialect of Isan. The area is located in the northeast, Kuan is a Southern dialect, indicating that the area is located in the south, and Mong is the western dialect. The area is located in the north.

The name can also indicate the location of a geographic location, such as a waterfall (the water on the hill falls to the cliffs). Gorge (his deep channel). Cliffs (rock at the hill, such as cliffs. Slopes, mountains such as cliffs, mountains with the land that cliffs), etc.

It can be seen from the Don Chedi, etc. The geography of Suphanburi. The landscape is the north. And west There are areas with the river. The Tha Chin River flows through the river basin (Tha Chin), a major rice growing area of Thailand. Suphanburi is Thailand's 21st Prime Minister, Banharn Silpa-archa, and many famous people from many provinces such as Maekwan Chitrong, Sripratan Surapol, Sombat Charoen, Khun Poompuang Duangchan, Prof. Dr. Sombat Thamrongthanawong. Attractions such as Wat Rong Wua Chawak honor. Buffalo Thai Buffalo Village Sam Chuk Market Supanburi is also home to Ban Somdet Chao Phraya Rajabhat University, U-Thong, Dvaravati Campus (Yasodhong Pool), located at Sa-Yai Sub-District, U Thong District, Suphan Buri Province. Geographical nouns are useful in the knowledge of the meaning of the names of places, because the words that comprise the name of each place have their own meaning. In addition, the name is also useful to know the history of the name of the place that the name has come from any time. Set up in any occasion Or how has it changed? Some places may be called according to the physical location, social traditions, such as the name of the leader. The name of the place is called by the natural environment, such as the water valley, the city of Chonburi, Pathum Thani, Bo Yang, Huaymud, etc. The name refers to social traditions, many of them are called by religion, such as the holy saint (saint) Or called by history, such as the cities of Athens and Rome or called by the settlers, such as many cities in the United States. America And Australia is named after the city in England. Losantiville was renamed Cincinatus in honor of the important people in the Revolutionary War.

The name of the place, in addition to being used as an indication or reference source, is for reference or mutual recognition. It also provides other interesting information such as the landscape of the village, such as Non Sung House, Nakhon Ratchasima, etc. Tell the terrain of the village that on the hill. Tell the story about people who live in terms of occupation, such as home, home, etc., tell the background. Those living in the area, such as New York, say that the original homestead of the **first** settlers came from York, England. When they settled in New York, they were called New York.

Natural and human-related processes produce topography, which is the surface of the Earth that represents the horizontal dimension. And vertical integration (The Science and Mathematics Textbook Project, San Francisco., 2002: 5).

Terrain refers to the physical and natural characteristics of the land. Include the lower elevations of the surface of the earth, lakes, roads, and cities (Dictionary of the Royal Academy 1999: 825 pages). Topography refers to the shape of the surface of the Earth. The low altitude is uneven, causing a high altitude, low ground and water surface if the surface of the world is flat. All is not a terrain. (Thailand Philanthropy, 1991)

Relief means the difference in altitude of the area, such as the valley, mountain valley, have different altitudes. This low altitude, when considered an overview, is called. Topography (Paiboon Boonchai, 2006)

The first order of relief is to define two broad groups of landforms: (1) continental platforms; The ocean floor (Ocean basins) is the earth, the ocean floor, and the ocean, which is approximately 71% of the surface of the world. Second Order of Relief is a low altitude, both continental and oceanic, with varying heights. For example, the continent has its own terrain and structures, such as the new alpine chains and old stone structures. Continental shields, etc. The topography under the ocean floor. Including the insertion of melting rocks from the crust beneath the crust. It is a process that makes the tectonic plates increase in height. Earth leveling It is a process that causes the crust to be leveled down. The terrain that is seen today

This research is a geography study of the village of Suphanburi. Qualitative Approach By

studying the name of the village in Suphan Buri Province, 1,008 villages were classified by geographical classification. And land use After that, collect the aliases in each group. And the meaning of each word. And analyze the characteristics of the area from the pseudonym.

The results

The results of the geographic study of the villages in Suphan Buri province showed that Geographical classification of the landscape. The total number of 700 villages and the highest number of water and water sources was 321 villages, followed by the highlands of 127 villages. The total land area of 97 villages was 69 water areas. There are 54 villages in the lowlands, 25 villages and 7 villages in the villages.

The geological characteristics of Suphan Buri province referring to the geographic features of Suphan Buri Province consisted of the western mountainous area, Dan Chang District. There are 7 hill tribe villages in the area. The foothills are the area between the mountains and the lowlands in the north of the province. There are 8 villages in the middle of the group is Mueang Suphanburi. There are 1 village and the southwestern part of Uthong District. There are 9 villages.

The use of land (Land use) found that the use of land based on the area, such as Dan Chang. There is mostly space. So the land is a hill tribe forest, including bamboo, which is located in the area is not high. What areas of the river flow through the river, such as Amphoe Ton Ngang, Amphoe Sam Chuk, Si Prachan. Amphoe Mueang Suphan Buri Bang Pla Ma District And the two brothers, etc., making the area is flat. It is suitable for cultivation of plants, so the use of land is a farmer's farm.
